A parent sign-up sheet with time slots and shirt size request to be put up in the lobby by December 2<sup>nd</sup>, the week leading up to the bagging event.

Rebecca reported that she completed setting up a giving tree at Pick N Save for gift card donations, which could also be used to benefit Kids Kitchen and other nutritional programming.

Brian has been in communication with the city government building to set up list of needs for the Giving Tree. Will need to have kids decorated box by November 14<sup>th</sup>. The box will be picked up from the government building by December 21<sup>st</sup>. Martha will help promote this program via email and social media.

Scott and Jill Walker led a discussion related to upcoming Glow Party. The group decided that the event would best be held in the B&G Club facility (as opposed to renting a venue), as long as we monitor capacity. The date for the Glow Party to be February 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2019. Scott announced he will have approx. 10 adult volunteers on hand and his group will be donating the use of sound equipment, DJs, light equipment and a supply of glow items. Nikki will start soliciting businesses for raffle items/baskets. She will track donations electronically. Nikki also stated she would use a Walmart gift card application for paper goods required for the event. The group agreed the raffle should be held 'bucket' style, as opposed to auction. Brian stated that Sonny's is willing to donate pizza to the event. Brian also offered to look into a sign sponsor for the event. Rebecca will look into Flanigan distributing as a beverage sponsor. Martha will use social media to promote the event and recruit donations for the bake sale. This will be a good opportunity to draw in parents who have expressed interest in supporting the parent committee but aren't able to attend meetings.
